BARGAINING UNIT AMENDMENT
AFSCME Local 1670

Rep. Pet. No. 17-07-1110

Employer: City of Newark, Delaware

Union Representative: AFSCME Local 1670

Affected Employees: Bargaining unit of “all hourly, non-supervisory employees of the City of Newark working in the Electric Department, the Parks and Recreation Department, the Planning and Development Department, and the Public Works-Water Resources Department, including its Maintenance Division, the Streets Division, the Refuse Division, and the Water and Waste Water Divisions.”

Upon petition by the exclusive bargaining representative, AFSCME Local 1670, and without objection from the public employer, the City of Newark, the bargaining unit of City employees currently represented by AFSCME Local 1670 is amended by severing a new bargaining unit constituted of: *All hourly, non-supervisory employees of the City of Newark in skilled trades positions.* This bargaining unit shall be represented by AFSCME Local 3919.

As a result of this petition, the remaining bargaining unit represented by AFSCME Local 1670 shall be defined as:

All hourly, non-supervisory employees of the City of Newark holding custodial, maintenance and equipment operation positions.

By agreement of the City and AFSCME Local 1670, this bargaining unit currently includes the following positions:

Building Maintenance Worker	Refuse Collector
Custodian II	Refuse Driver/Collector
Equipment Operator	Refuse Driver I
Equipment Operator II	Refuse Driver II
Equipment Operator III	Refuse Coordinator
Heavy Equipment Operator/Mechanic	Street Sweeper Operator
Maintenance I	Transfer Station Operator
Maintenance III	Water & Waste Water Mechanic
Maintenance IV	Water Meter Technician
