**NOTICE OF BARGAINING UNIT
 DETERMINATION and ELECTION ORDER**

Pursuant to §1310 of the Public Employment Relations Act (19 Del.C. Chapter 13), Laborers' International Union of North America, Local 1029 (LIUNA Local 1029) filed a petition seeking to represent a bargaining unit of unrepresented employees for purposes of collective bargaining. The bargaining unit is defined to include:

ALL FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME INSTITUTIONAL SECURITY AND SECURITY OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY THE STATE OF DELAWARE, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, DELAWARE PSYCHIATRIC CENTER, IN THE MITCHELL BUILDING, EXCLUDING SUPERVISORY EMPLOYEES.

This petition has been verified by the Public Employment Relations Board and determined to be properly filed and supported by at least thirty percent (30%) of the employees in the proposed bargaining unit. Any objections to the validation of this petition should be addressed to the PERB at the number and address above and must be received within five (5) days of the posting of this Notice. All questions regarding this petition should also be addressed to the PERB.

The composition of the proposed bargaining unit is not in dispute. Consequently, a secret ballot election will be conducted by the Public Employment Relations Board among all members of the bargaining unit defined above to determine whether they desire to be represented for purposes of collective bargaining.

Any organization other than LIUNA LOCAL 1029 which desires to be included on the ballot must, within ten (10) days of this notice, submit a 10% (ten percent) showing of interest to the Public Employment Relations Board.

This Notice will be followed by a Notice of Election advising eligible voters of the election arrangements. Any questions regarding this matter should be addressed to the Public Employment Relations Board at the address and telephone number above.
