**NOTICE OF PROPOSED BARGAINING UNIT CERTIFICATION
 and ELECTION ORDER**

Pursuant to §1610 of the Police Officers and Firefighters Employment Relations Act (19 Del.C. Chapter 16), International Brotherhood of Teamsters Local 326 filed a petition seeking to represent for purposes of collective bargaining a bargaining unit which includes:

**All full-time Town of Millsboro Police Officers,
 excluding the Chief of Police**

This petition has been verified by the Public Employment Relations Board and has been determined to be timely filed and supported by at least thirty percent (30%) of the employees in the proposed bargaining unit. Any objections to the validation of this petition should be addressed to the PERB at the number and address above and must be received within five (5) days of the posting of this Notice.

There were no substantive objections raised to the appropriateness of the proposed composition of this bargaining unit.

A secret ballot election will be conducted by the Public Employment Relations Board among all members of the proposed bargaining unit to determine whether they desire to be represented for purposes of collective bargaining.

Any organization other than Teamsters Local 326 which desires to be included on the ballot must, within ten (10) days of this notice, submit a 10% (ten percent) showing of interest.

This Notice will be followed by a Notice of Election advising eligible voters of the election arrangements. Any questions regarding this matter should be addressed to the Public Employment Relations Board at the address and telephone number above.
