On or about September 13, 2013, AFSCME Council 81, by and through its affiliated Local 821 filed a Petition for Bargaining Unit Clarification with the Public Employment Relations Board, seeking to clarify the bargaining unit status of “reported time employees”. Specifically, the petition sought clarification of the bargaining unit of Colonial School District which was defined to include, “all full-time and regular part-time custodians, maintenance employees, groundskeepers and couriers.”

By correspondence dated September 17, 2013, Colonial School District responded:

Colonial School District does not consider any employee group and/or classification s reported time [employees]. Currently, all full-time and regular part-time custodians, maintenance employees, groundskeepers and couriers are contained within our collective bargaining agreement between Colonial School District Board of Education and American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees AFL-CIO Local 218 of Council 81.

Thereafter, by correspondence dated October 11, 2013, AFSCME responded:


[AFSCME] is in agreement that the District does not employ any employees who are reported time employees and that all employees are properly included in the bargaining unit.

AFSCME requested to withdraw the petition.

WHEREFORE, this Petition for Bargaining Unit Clarification is hereby dismissed.
