**BACKGROUND**

1. The State of Delaware is a public employer within the meaning of 19 Del.C. §1302(p) of the Public Employment Relations Act, 19 Del.C. Chapter 13, (“PERA”). Justice of the Peace Court (“JP Court”) is an agency of the State.

2. The Delaware State and Federal Employees Local 1029, Laborers International Union of North America, AFL-CIO (“LIUNA Local 1029”) is an employee organization within the meaning of §1302(i) of the PERA. At the time the Charge was filed, LIUNA Local 1029 was engaged in an organizing campaign and had filed a petition to be certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of a unit of full-time and part-time

Security Officers employed by JP Court and working in Sussex County courts, within the meaning of §1302(j).

3. On or about August 24, 2018, LIUNA Local 1029 filed an Unfair Labor Practice Charge alleging JP Court personnel had engaged in conduct which violated 19 Del.C. §1307(a)(1) and (a)(3). The Charge was forwarded to the State for response.


4. At the State's request, an extension was granted in which to file its Answer to the Charge.

5. Thereafter, by email dated September 19, 2018, LIUNA Local 1029 advised PERB the parties had successfully resolved the dispute underlying this Charge and requested the Charge be withdrawn, reserving its right to refile the Charge in the event of the breach of the parties' agreement.

**WHEREFORE**, this unfair labor practice charge is hereby dismissed.
