PURPOSE OF ELECTION

ELIGIBILITY RULES

Secret Ballot Election Procedures Through U.S. Mail

The election will be conducted by SECRET ballot through U.S. Mail. Eligible employees will receive a Secret Ballot, Instructions, and a stamped, addressed return envelope at their home addresses. Ballots will be mailed on or before 5:00 p.m., on **Monday**, **July 27**, **2020**.

In order for a ballot to be valid, the instructions must be carefully followed, and the ballot must be received in the PERB office by no later than 12:00 noon on Wednesday, August 12, 2020.

The marked ballot must be sealed in the OFFICIAL SECRET BALLOT envelope provided. The voter will return the sealed ballot to the PERB in the stamped, addressed return envelope provided. The return envelope must contain the signature of the voting employee in the space provided in order to be valid. The signed envelopes will be separated from the sealed ballot envelopes prior to the opening of the sealed ballots in order to maintain secrecy.

AUTHORIZED OBSERVERS

Both the employer and the union (FOP Lodge 20) will be permitted to appoint one representative to observe the official counting of the ballots.

The Public Employment Relations Act provides that only one valid representation election may be held in a twelve (12) month period.
