BACKGROUND

1. General Teamsters Local 326 (“Local 326”) is an employee organization within the meaning of §1602(g) of the Police Officers and Firefighters Employment Relations Act (“PERA”), 19 Del. C. Chapter 16. Local 326 is the exclusive bargaining representative of a bargaining unit of City of Lewes Police Officers below the rank of Lieutenant, within the meaning of 19 Del. C. §1602(h).

2. The City of Lewes, Delaware is a public employer within the meaning of 19 Del. C. §1602(i).

3. On June 9, 2020, Local 326 filed an unfair labor practice charge with the Delaware Public Employment Relations Board (“PERB”) alleging the City had engaged in conduct which violated 19 Del. C. §1607(a)(5).


4. On or about June 19, 2020, the parties mutually requested the processing of this Charge be stayed “... to provide time for the parties to attempt to reach an amicable resolution of the dispute.”

5. By email dated August 20, 2020, counsel for Local 326 advised PERB that the parties had amicably resolved their differences and executed a Memorandum of Understanding. Local 326 requested to withdraw the charge with prejudice.

WHEREFORE, this unfair labor practice charge is hereby dismissed.
