**NOTICE OF CERTIFICATION PETITION

Pursuant to §1310 of the Public Employment Relations Act (PERA, 19 Del. C. Chapter 13), Communications Workers of America, AFL-CIO, CLC (“CWA”) filed a petition seeking to represent a bargaining unit of employees which includes:

**ALL FULL-TIME AND REGULAR PART-TIME NON-
 UNIFORMED COMMUNICATIONS DISPATCHERS EMPLOYED
 BY THE DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY,
 DIVISION OF CAPITOL POLICE**

The petition has been verified by the Public Employment Relations Board and has been determined to be timely filed and supported by at least thirty percent (30%) of the employees in the proposed bargaining unit. Any objections to the validation of this petition should be addressed to the PERB at the number and address above and must be received within five (5) days of the posting of this Notice. All questions regarding this petition should also be addressed to the PERB.

The State did not objection to the composition of the proposed bargaining unit. Consequently, the unit is determined to be appropriate within the meaning of 19 Del. C. §1310.

A secret ballot election will be conducted by the Public Employment Relations Board among all employees in the proposed bargaining unit to determine whether they desire to be represented for purposes of collective bargaining.

Any organization other than COMMUNICATIONS WORKERS OF AMERICA which seeks to be included on the ballot must, within ten (10) days of this notice, submit a 10% (ten percent) showing of interest to the Delaware Public Employment Relations Board.
