POLLING TO BE CONDUCTED ELECTRONICALLY

PURPOSE OF ELECTION

AN ELECTION BY SECRET BALLOT WILL BE CONDUCTED, under the supervision of the Public Employment Relations Board, among all regular full-time and regular part-time **Judicial Case Managers I, II, III and Mediation/Arbitration Officers** employed in the Justice of the Peace Court Mediation Unit, to determine whether those employees desire to be represented by LiUNA Local 1029 for purposes of collective bargaining, as part of the existing bargaining unit of JP Court Security Officers, Constables and Judicial Case Processors.

ELIGIBLE VOTERS

**All Regular Full-Time and Regular Part-Time
JUDICIAL CASE MANAGERS I, II, III
MEDIATION/ARBITRATION OFFICERS
employed by Justice of the Peace Court in the Mediation Unit**

Employees defined as ELIGIBLE VOTERS who did not work during the payroll period because they were ill or on vacation or temporarily laid off and employees in the military service of the United States are eligible to vote.

Secret Ballot Election Procedures

This election will be by SECRET ballot cast electronically through the State of Delaware email system.

- Each eligible voter will receive an email from the Public Employment Relations Board which includes a sample ballot.
- The email will include a “voting button” with the option for the eligible voters to either choose for this group to be represented by LiUNA Local 1029, as part of the existing bargaining unit of JP Court employees (YES) or for the group to remain unrepresented (NO).
- Voters will cast their votes by clicking the voting button icon in the “Respond” options, clicking their choice, and then sending the responsive email back to PERB. Instructions will be provided in the email to all voters. In the event that voters have difficulty finding the voting buttons, they may simply respond to the email by typing either “YES” or “NO”.

Authorized Observers

LiUNA Local 1029 and JP Court may each designate one observer and one alternate to observe the counting of the ballots on Friday, June 12, 2026, at 1:00 PM. The observers should be persons familiar with the eligible voters.

INFORMATION CONCERNING THE ELECTION

THE RESULTS OF THIS ELECTION WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST. The ballots will be counted on **June 12 at 1:00 PM.** The Public Employment Relations Act provides that only one valid representation election may be held in a twelve (12) month period.

All votes must be cast by email on or before noon on Friday, June 12, 2026.
