POLLING TO BE CONDUCTED ELECTRONICALLY

PURPOSE OF ELECTION

AN ELECTION BY SECRET BALLOT WILL BE CONDUCTED, under the supervision of the Public Employment Relations Board, among all **REGULAR FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME CONSTABLES EMPLOYED BY THE COLONIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**, to determine whether those employees desire to be represented by the Colonial Paraprofessionals Association (“CPA”), DSEA/NEA, for purposes of collective bargaining, as part of the existing bargaining unit defined in DOL Case 128.

ELIGIBLE VOTERS

**ALL REGULAR FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME CONSTABLES
EMPLOYED BY THE COLONIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**
(excluding Lead Constables)

Employees defined as ELIGIBLE VOTERS who did not work during the payroll period because they were ill or on vacation or temporarily laid off and employees in the military service of the United States are eligible to vote.

Secret Ballot Election Procedures

This election will be by SECRET ballot cast electronically through the State of Delaware email system.

- Each eligible voter will receive an email from the Public Employment Relations Board which includes a sample ballot and an electronic voting option.
- The email provides each voter with the option to either choose “YES” (indicating a choice for the group to be represented as part of the existing paraprofessionals bargaining unit represented by CPA, DSEA/NEA) or “NO” for the group to remain unrepresented.
- Voters will cast their votes by replying directly to the email back to PERB typing in either **YES** or **NO**. Instructions will be provided in the email to each voter.

Authorized Observers

Colonial Paraprofessional Association and the District may each designate one observer and one alternate to observe the counting of the ballots on Tuesday, June 23, 2026, at 1:00 PM. The observers should be persons familiar with the eligible voters.

INFORMATION CONCERNING THE ELECTION

THE RESULTS OF THIS ELECTION WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST. The ballots will be counted on **Tuesday, June 23, 2026, at 1:00 PM.** The Public School Employment Relations Act provides that only one valid representation election may be held in a twelve (12) month period.

All votes must be cast by email on or before noon on Tuesday, June 23, 2026.
